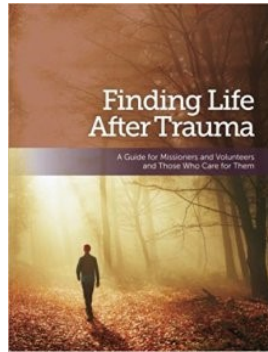
Resources for Volunteers and Missioners

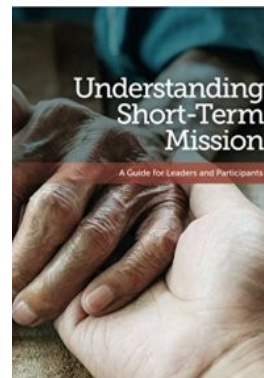

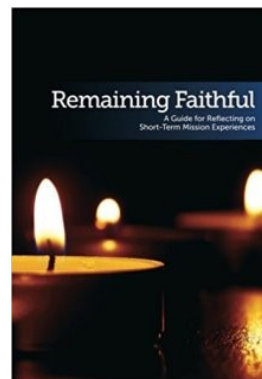
Returning Home: A Guide for Missioners and Volunteers in Transition

Information for people at home—friends, co-workers, parishes, families, religious communities, and sending organizations—on ways to support a volunteer or missioner in transition

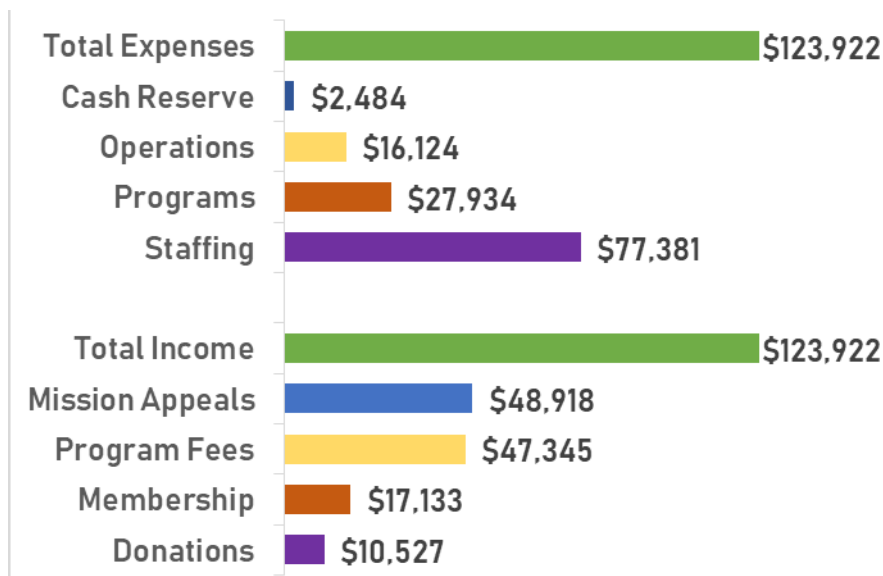


Remaining Faithful: A Guide for Reflecting on Short-Term Mission Experiences
